In advance of the volunteering session, group leads will be provided with the following information by a member of National Trust staff. It's really important that you read and check your understanding of these documents prior to your volunteering session.

- Risk assessment for the volunteering activity
- Activity briefing notes (covering Covid-safe practices on site)
- Arrival and parking information
- Refreshments and lunch arrangements (if applicable)
- Process in case of bad weather

As group lead, there are a few points that you can follow to make sure that your volunteering activity goes ahead smoothly and safely on the day.

- You must let us know of any accessibility requirements, medical or additional needs of the group members in advance to allow us to plan for your volunteering safely
- You must have emergency contact details for your group members available on the day

As the group lead it's important that the members of your group know to stay away from the property if they have symptoms of coronavirus or if a member of their household has developed symptoms and is awaiting the outcome of a test. Individuals must also stay away from our places for 14 days if they are required to do so following contact from the NHS Test and Trace programme.

During the volunteering activity, if participants feel that they are asked to do anything which they feel unsure of, or haven't had the training for, they should inform the National Trust activity leader before starting. If anyone has any medical or other reason why they should not do any given task they should inform the leader at the start of the day.
